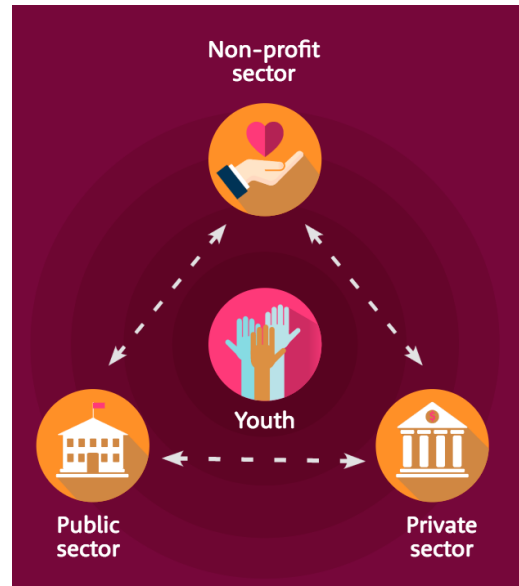

Set up your BCeID now!

We encourage anyone who is considering accessing a Canada-BC Job Grant for themselves or their employees to set up their BCeID right away. Applications using the new online system will start May 1, but in order to use the new system, both employer and employee will need to have their [BCeID](#).

Information about the new [Rural Stream can be found on the government website](#), if you are wondering if you are considered urban or rural, here is the definition used for eligibility of this stream:

For the purposes of the Rural Stream, jobs must be located in one or more of the following areas:

- 1. A community with a population of 25,000 or less, located outside the geographic boundaries of Metro Vancouver and the Capital Regional District.*
- 2. An unincorporated area with a population of 25,000 or less.*

There have been a number of eligibility changes recently. Check in with ASPECT about your training plans. As a delivery partner, ASPECT BC can assist with CJG applications under four streams of funding to which eligible employers can apply.
